DEAR PARENTS

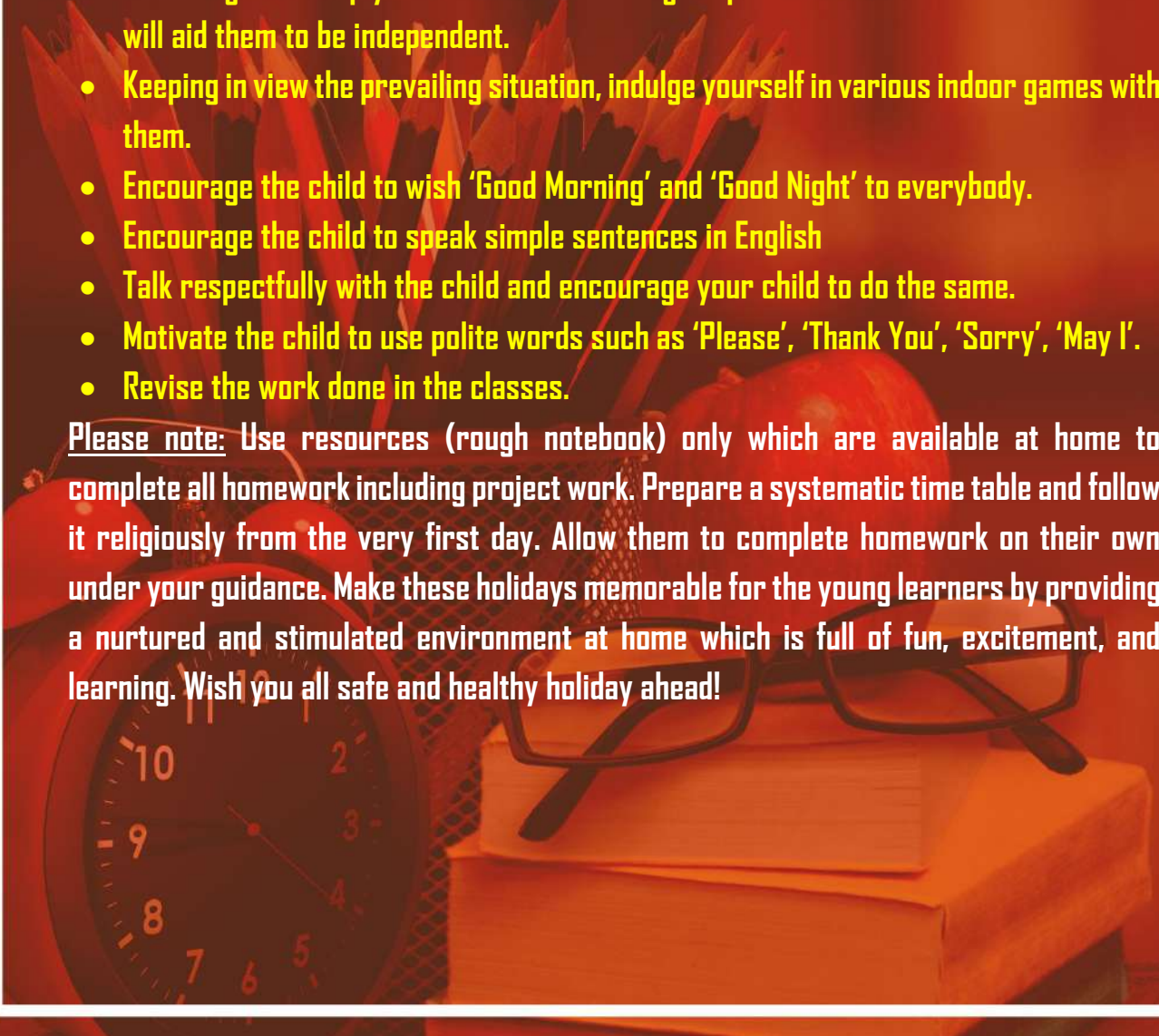
Vacation is the time for the children to explore their myriad interest and indulge in various activities which would lead to their all-round development.
